### **Reopening Date**

### **IMPORTANT UPDATE: Week of 10/26**

We have been planning to begin In Person, Full Time Learning on 10/26. *This plan may now change.* We will send all parents final notification of the method of schooling for the week of 10/26 (Hybrid or In Person) on Tuesday 10/20.

The reason for this later confirmation date on the learning model is due to a shipping delay in the equipment for our new ventilation systems. We will have secondary ventilation solutions in place until our new hospital grade ventilation systems arrive. Due to this change in plans, the Board will decide how we will be proceeding with our Learning Phases until our ventilation systems are installed. The Board is meeting on 10/19.
