

6th grade supply list – Mrs. Oberhaus 2021-22

- 1 – 1 ½ inch 3-ring binder
- 8 – dividers with pockets and holes for the 3-ring binder
- 2 – 100-page, wide ruled composition notebooks
- 1 – package wide-ruled, loose notebook paper with 3 holes
- 1 – package #2 pencils – sharpened
- 2 – large erasers
- 1 – pencil sharpener with cover to catch shavings
- 1 – supply box (approximately 9"x6"x2")
- 1 – Zippered pencil pouch with 3-ring grommet holes
- 2 – hand towels
- 1 – box of tissues
- An oversized shirt or apron for protecting clothes during art or painting
- A back pack that zips – for bringing items back and forth from school. This bag should be able to fit their binder.
- 1 pair of shoes to be worn inside only and left at school – these should fit well and not slip off while jumping or skipping
- 1 pair of outdoor shoes with laces for gym class and outside
- A water bottle and lunch box to bring to school each day
- A small, individual hand sanitizer with closeable lid for personal use (optional)
- Scissors (optional)

**Students will not be told this year what they should wear outside. I may recommend something, but ultimately it will be their decision what to wear and they will experience the natural consequences of their choice. They will not always have time to change clothes because they dressed inappropriately. I highly recommend that they are prepared for all types of weather by having the appropriate gear at school each day.

- A sun or baseball hat
- Rain boots, rain coat and pants for rainy or muddy weather
- Snow boots, pants, coat, hat, gloves, scarf for winter weather
- A small bag with a change of clothing including underwear and socks to be left at school
- Sunscreen (optional)
