

Class Three Supply List

The third grade year is a time for students to be fully responsible for their own routines and belongings. Please label all items with your child's name. Most school supplies (crayons, pencils, main lesson books, scissors, paper, etc.) will continue to be provided by the school, so please do not send extra supplies to class unless requested.

If possible, please bring the following items to school during the TBD Orientation Day. If you cannot attend the Orientation and Supply Drop Off day, please bring them the first day of school and leave them by your child's marked hook:

*A full change of labeled clothes (t-shirt, pants or shorts, underwear and socks) in a bag with their name on it. Extra pairs of socks are encouraged, as during rainy days the challenge of wet and dirty socks can pursue through several recesses.

*A raincoat, rain pants, and rain boots

*A winter coat, snow pants, snow boots, a hat, scarf, and gloves (for colder winter weather only). It would be helpful to have extra pairs of gloves as well provided, for the same reason as having extra socks would be helpful.

*A hat to protect from the sun

*A pair of inside shoes (athletic shoes with laces that can be tied)

On the first day of school, place the following near your child's hook outside the classroom before proceeding outside for morning recess:

*A backpack which they can carry on their own. Please be sure that this backpack can hold their lunch while still having some additional space for sweatshirts, jackets, etc., and that they are able to put everything in it on their own.

*A lunch box or bag with their snack (this is requested to be a non-processed fruit or vegetable) and lunch (enough healthy food to carry them through until 3:30) + utensils if needed. Please be aware that our snack is 10-15 minutes and lunch is 20-25 minutes. Packing healthy food for them that they will be able to eat in the given time is appreciated. We will not be sharing utensils this year, so please plan to provide your child with their own. We are a nut-free school so please be aware of all ingredients of the items in your child's lunch.

*A reusable water bottle

Optionally, you may want to include:

*A sweater or light jacket for cooler days

*A small personal use bottle of sanitizer that is at least 70% alcohol

Please do not allow your child to bring, now or at any point in the school year:

*Toys, games, stuffed animals, fidget spinners, or any other distracting item

*This includes backpack “charms” or items intended for use after school

*Any over-the-counter products such as sunscreen or bug spray (see office with questions)
