

Families whose household income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level, as defined by the EdChoice Expansion income eligibility requirements, are eligible for a waiver of the application fee and enrollment contract deposit.

EdChoice Expansion income eligibility thresholds are determined annually by the Ohio Department of Education and are published on the [Ohio.gov website](#).

Families applying for EdChoice Expansion who anticipate qualifying as low-income (200% of the poverty level or below) may request the fee waivers by confirming their anticipated eligibility via email to Spring Garden Waldorf School after submitting an application. If enrollment is offered, the enrollment contract deposit will also be waived.

If a family is later determined not to qualify as low-income by the Ohio Department of Education, Spring Garden Waldorf School will collect the application fee and enrollment contract deposit after the EdChoice scholarship eligibility and award amount are finalized.
